Mission

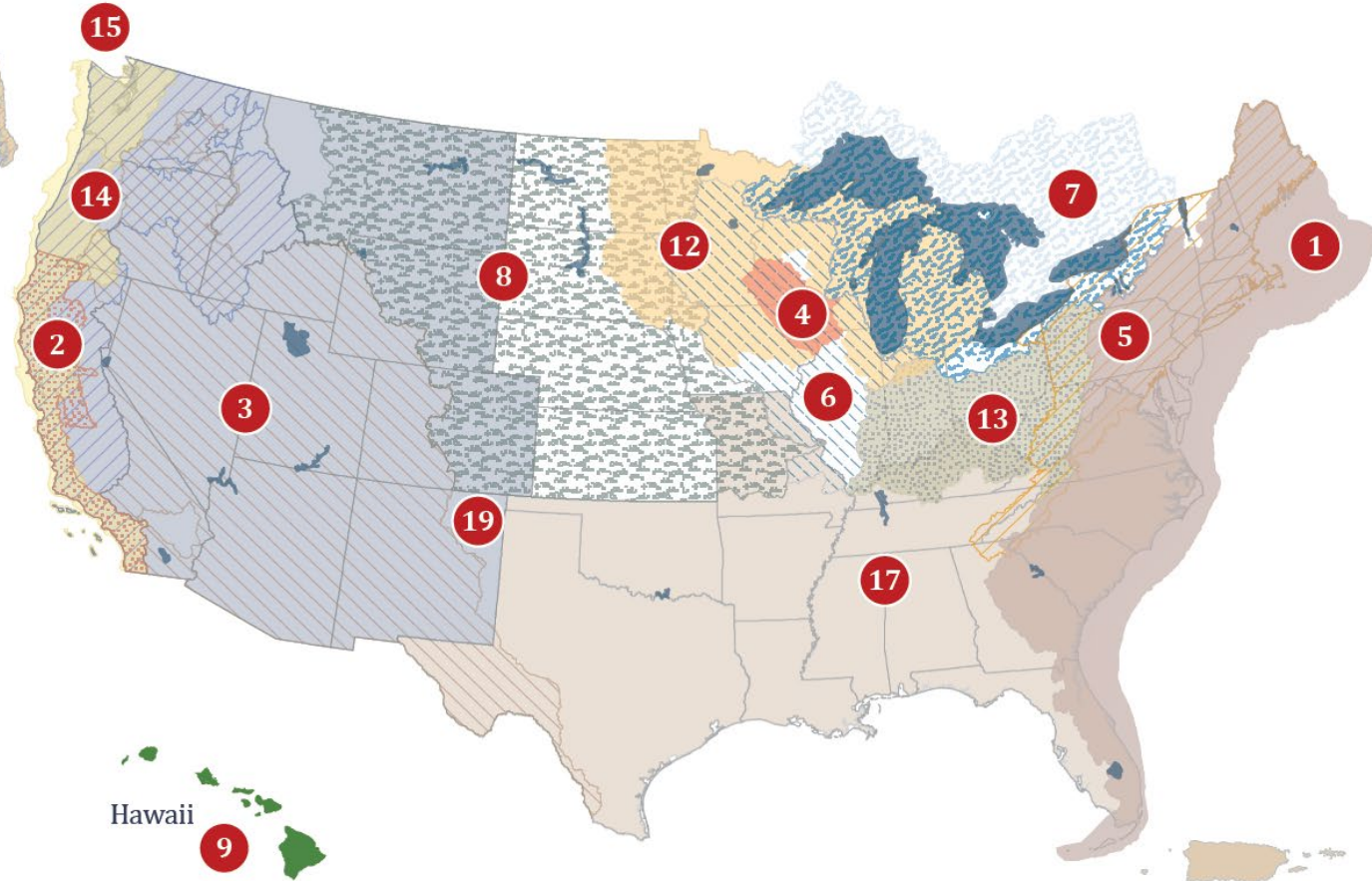
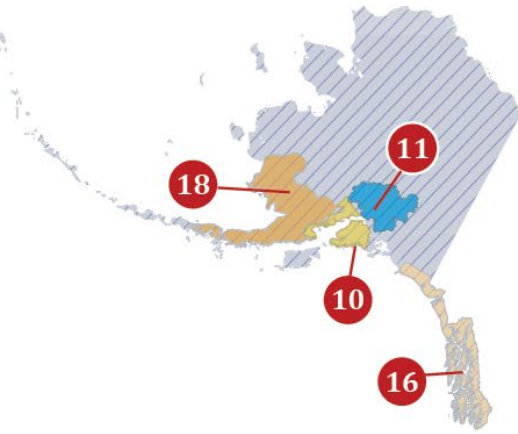
To **protect, restore, and enhance** the nation's fish and aquatic communities through partnerships that foster fish habitat conservation and improve the quality of life for the American people.



Goals

1. Protect and maintain intact and healthy aquatic systems
2. Prevent further degradation of fish habitats that have been adversely affected
3. Reverse declines in the quality and quantity of aquatic habitats to improve the overall health of fish and other aquatic organisms
4. Increase the quality and quantity of fish habitats that support a broad natural diversity of fish and other aquatic species

America's Conservation Enhancement (ACE) Act 2020

- Codifies the National Fish Habitat Partnership
- Expands the Board membership to 26
- Authorizes funding to partner organizations
- Adds Congressional reporting requirements
- Among others



Conservation Priorities for FY22

1. Protect intact healthy waters
2. Restore hydrologic conditions for fish
3. Reconnect fragmented fish habitats
4. Restore water quality
5. Coordination and operational support for FHPs
