In accordance with provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), we enclose for your review the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS) on the Makah Tribe Request to Hunt Gray Whales.

The proposed action is to respond to the Makah Tribe's request for a waiver of the Marine Mammal Protection Act (MMPA) to resume treaty-based hunting of eastern North Pacific gray whales (*Eschrichtius robustus*) for ceremonial and subsistence purposes.
