## I. Introduction

This is NMFS' policy on how to clarify the role of peer review in activities undertaken by NMFS under authority of the ESA. This policy is intended to complement and not circumvent or supersede the current public review processes in the listing and recovery programs.

## II. Objective

Independent peer review will be solicited on listing recommendations and draft recovery plans to ensure the best biological and commercial information is being used in the decision making process, as well as to ensure that reviews by recognized experts are incorporated into the review process of rulemakings and recovery plans developed in accordance with the requirements of the Act.

## III. Guidance
