

MAFAC CBP Task Force
Proposed Framework for SCEE Section of Phase 2 CBP Report

Objective: Telling a story about what it is going to take to achieve these goals, from social, cultural, economic, and ecological perspectives. Provide a platform for Task Force members to have a voice.

Proposed Template:

1. Briefly describe interest/sector (2-3 Paragraphs). Describe key characteristics and include qualitative and quantifiable (e.g. economics) information. Include any personal stories, if desired, from where you sit in the basin.
2. Briefly describe fish/water connection (2-3 paragraphs). What happens when you turn the dials?
3. Describe implications of each scenario to social, cultural, economic, and ecosystem considerations as they relate to your interest, others' interests, and the collective/basin wide interest. (1-3 pages).
4. Include big bold ideas on innovative approaches to help achieve the goals. (1-3 pages).
5. What it means to be part of a collaboration and partnership. Describe any shift in views from the CBP Task Force experience. (1-2 pages).

Interest/Sectors to Cover

We are suggesting that these interests/sectors be covered in the stories, an approach to consider is that a few Task Force members might jointly craft stories, or an individual may do one on their own. Over the course of development, we may decide to merge or keep as standalone stories.

- Irrigation
- Ranching/agriculture
- Transportation - barging, ports, alternatives & innovations
- Commercial Fisheries – including secondary services (boat builders, suppliers, restaurants, hotel)
- Recreational Fishing – including secondary services (boat builders, suppliers, restaurants, hotel)
- Communities & local culture
- Hydro system - energy sources, customer impacts, economic impacts, alternatives & innovations
- Social Equity
- Tribal culture
- Ecosystem – dependent wildlife/orcas
- Others – tourism, chambers of commerce and local government interests, local/regional economy
- Youth & next generation
