

22382 TRANSPORT INFORMATION


SeaWorld has been instrumental in the development of successful transport techniques for marine mammals (Joseph, et al. 1991, Yip, et al. 2018). SeaWorld has considerable experience in the transport of cetaceans, including cetaceans of the same size, weight and species. Therefore, the nature of this transport is not without precedent.


The animal will be transported in a specially designed and constructed transport unit. Transport will be via charter aircraft and truck in accordance with professionally accepted techniques and in compliance with all applicable regulations, standards, and conditions set forth under the Marine Mammal Protection Act, the Animal Welfare Act and the Lacey Act. Transport is anticipated to take approximately 8 hours, absent unusual circumstances. The transport procedures were reviewed and certified as appropriate in a letter from Dr. Nollens attached to the application.

The animal will be transported under the direct supervision of the SeaWorld professional staff. At least one staff veterinarian will accompany the animal at all times during the move. We have attached for your consideration an illustration of the transport unit which will be utilized to move this Pacific white-sided dolphin.
