Dear Fish Buyers (Processors) and Sellers (Harvesters):

Our records indicate that you are a potential buyer or harvester of Southeast Alaska purse seine salmon. The buyer who first purchases the salmon landed is responsible for collecting and submitting the loan repayment fees to NOAA Fisheries. The harvester is responsible for repaying the \$13,331,030 reduction loan which financed the Southeast Alaska purse seine salmon fishing capacity reduction program.

Fee payment and collection will begin on July 22, 2012. The initial fee applicable to the Southeast Alaska purse seine salmon program's reduction fishery is 3% of landed value and any subsequent bonus payments. Please see the attached Federal Register notice for more details.

Please note that payments must be received no later than the 15th calendar day after the last calendar day of each month for the previous month's landings. NOAA Fisheries uses Pay.gov to accept buyback fee payments online via a checking account and to submit the fee collection report. Please visit Pay.gov and search under NOAA for current buyback program samples.
