Dear Reviewer:

In accordance with provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), we enclose for your review the *Final Environmental Impact Statement for Steller Sea Lion Protection Measures for Groundfish Fisheries in the Bering Sea and Aleutian Islands Management Area (FEIS)*.

This FEIS is prepared pursuant to NEPA to assess the environmental, social, and economic impacts associated with NOAA proceeding with revisions to the Steller sea lion protection measures. NOAA listed the western distinct population segment of Steller sea lions as endangered under the Endangered Species Act and has designated critical habitat to protect haulout, rookery, and foraging locations throughout Alaska waters. This proposed action would implement management measures for the Aleutian Islands Atka mackerel, Pacific cod, and pollock fisheries that minimize the potential fishery impacts on Steller sea lions while minimizing economic impacts on the fisheries, to the extent practicable. These management measures would disperse fishing effort over time and area to minimize potential competition for important Steller sea lion prey species. The protection measures are focused on the fisheries that may affect Steller sea lions or their critical habitat in the Aleutian Islands because that is where Steller sea lions are experiencing population declines.

NOAA is not required to respond to comments received during the agency's 30 day comment period as a result of the issuance of the FEIS. However, NOAA will review and consider comments received by June 27, 2014, for their impact on issuance of a record of decision (ROD). The ROD will be made available publicly following final agency action on or after November 1, 2014.
