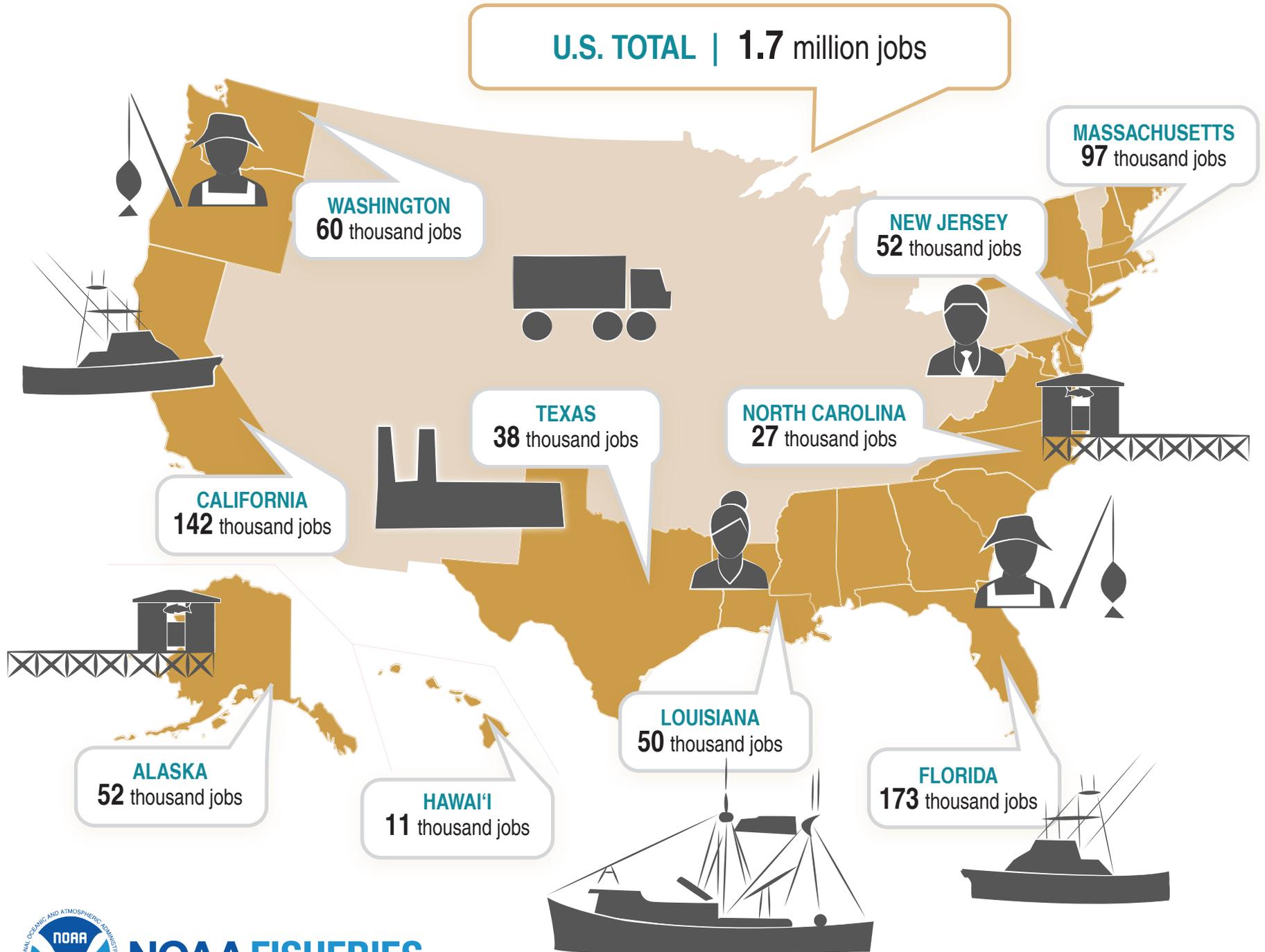

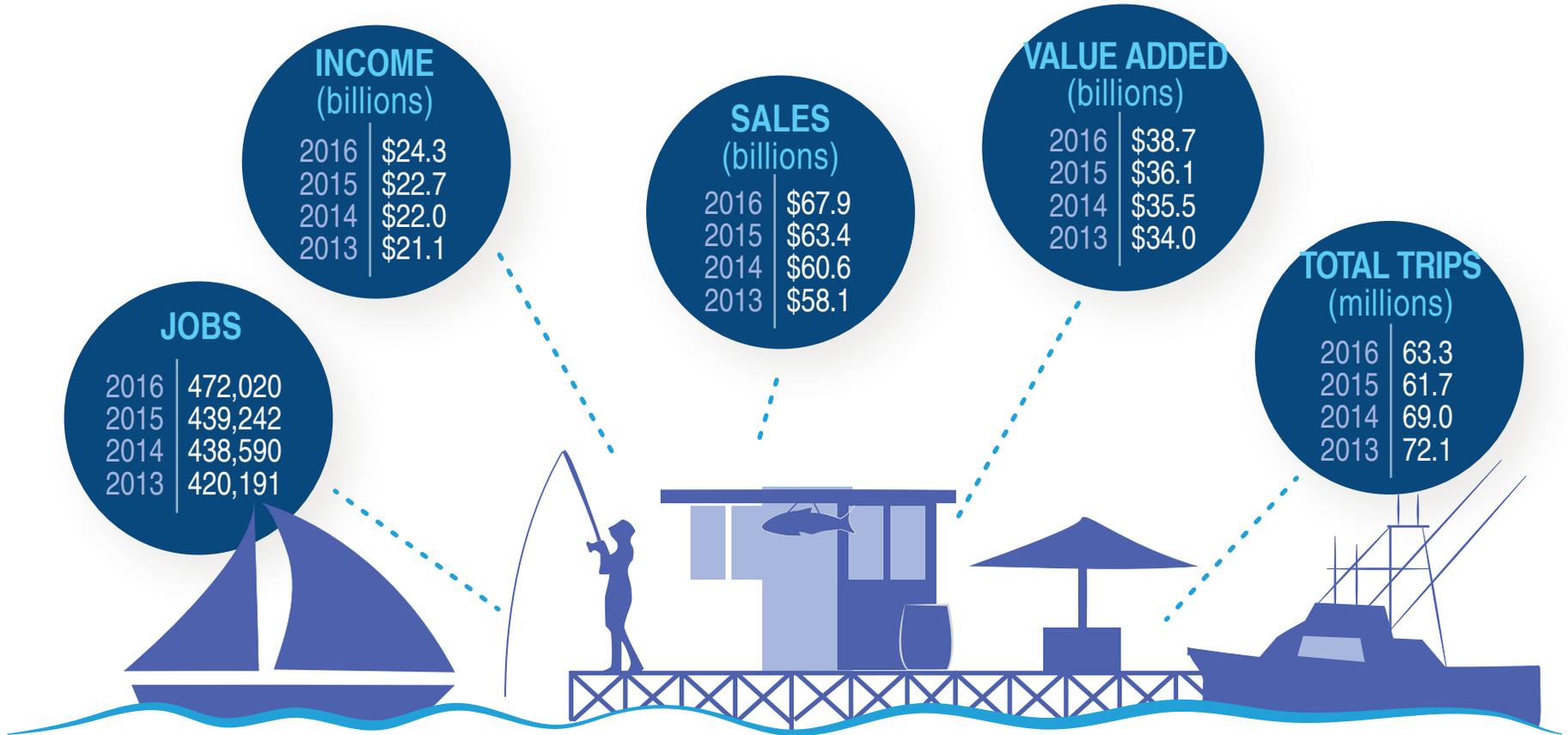

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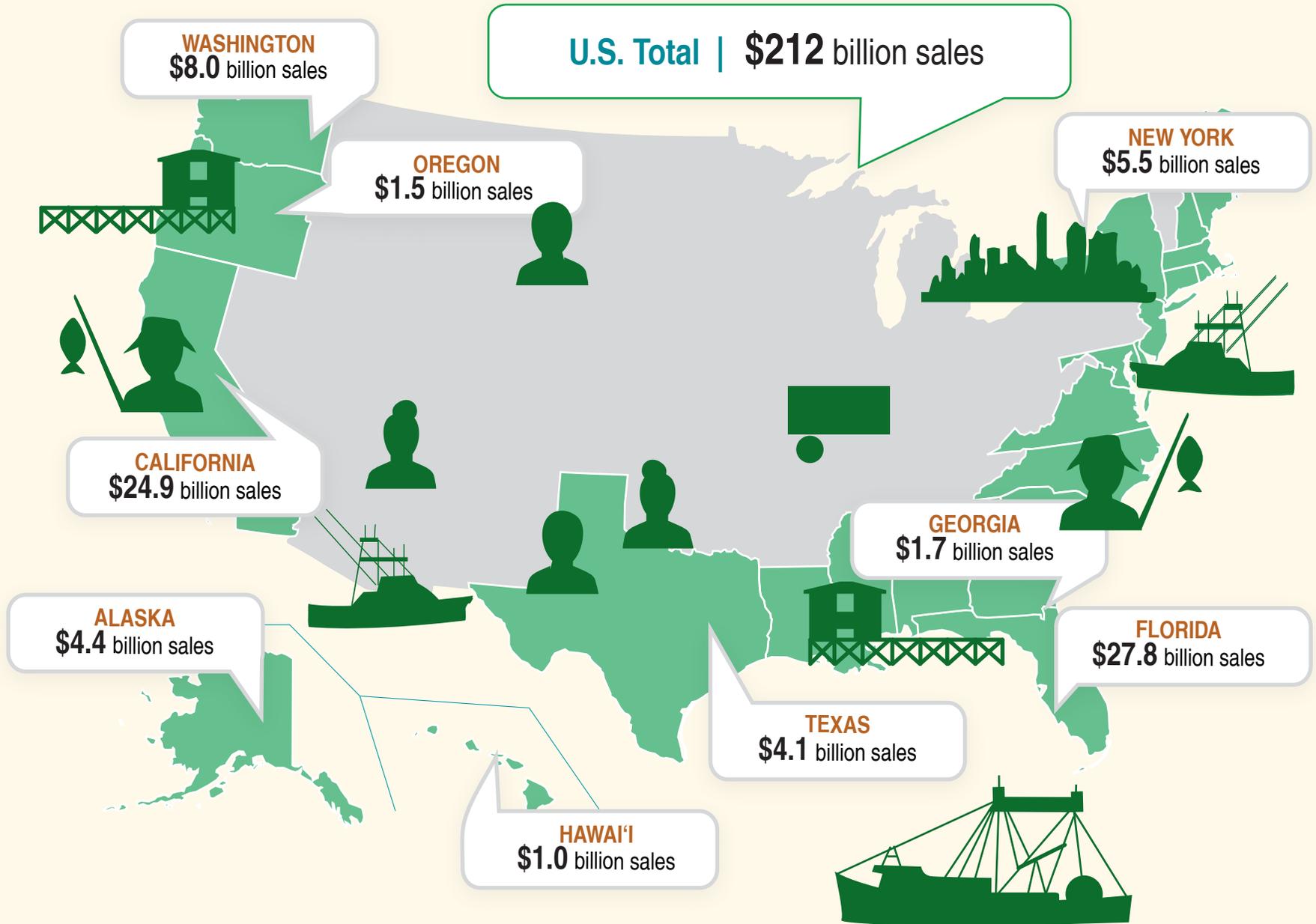
U.S. Recreational Fisheries Economic Impact Trends, 2016*

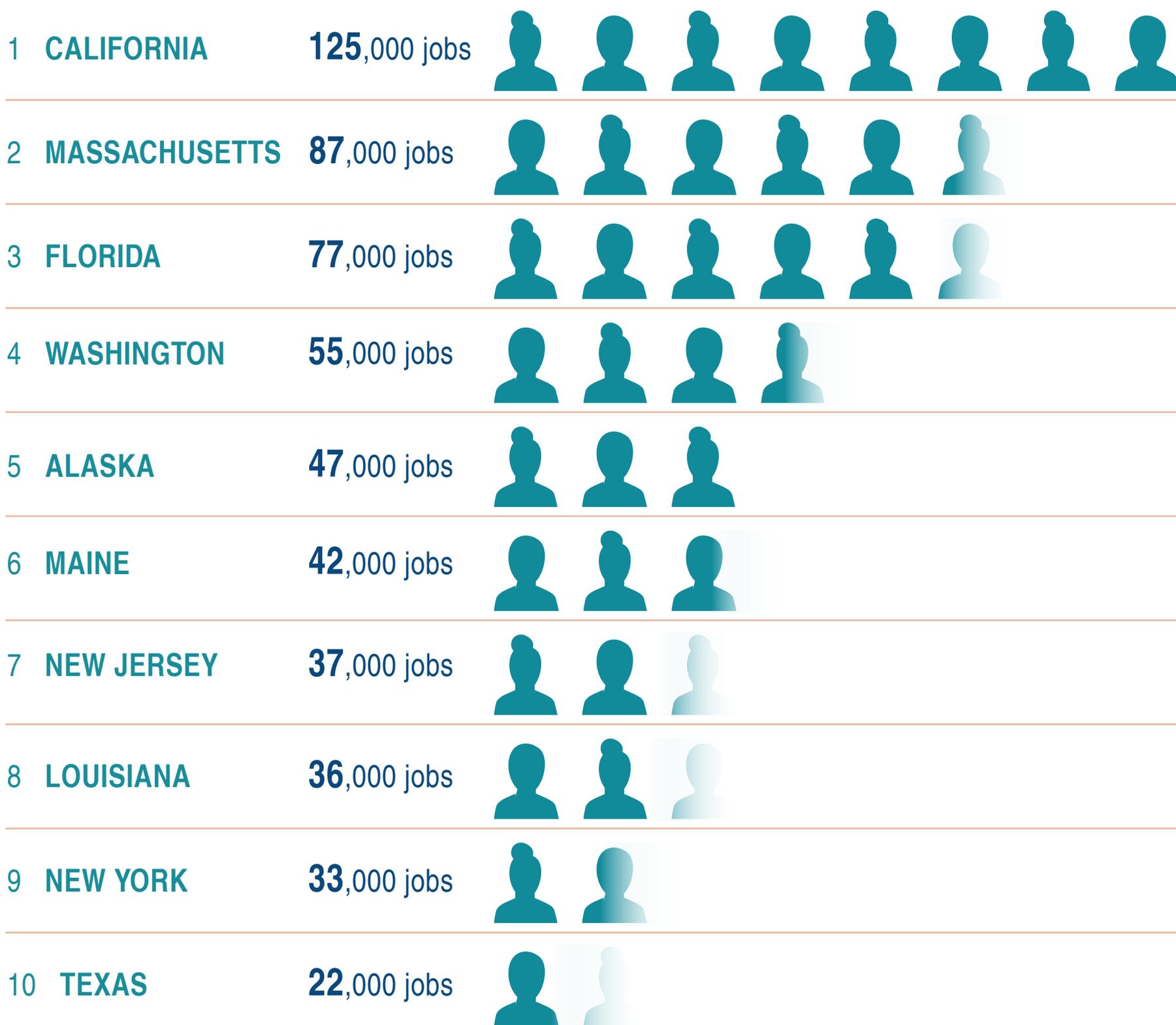
Total Sales* Generated by U.S. Commercial and Recreational Fishing Industries, 2016



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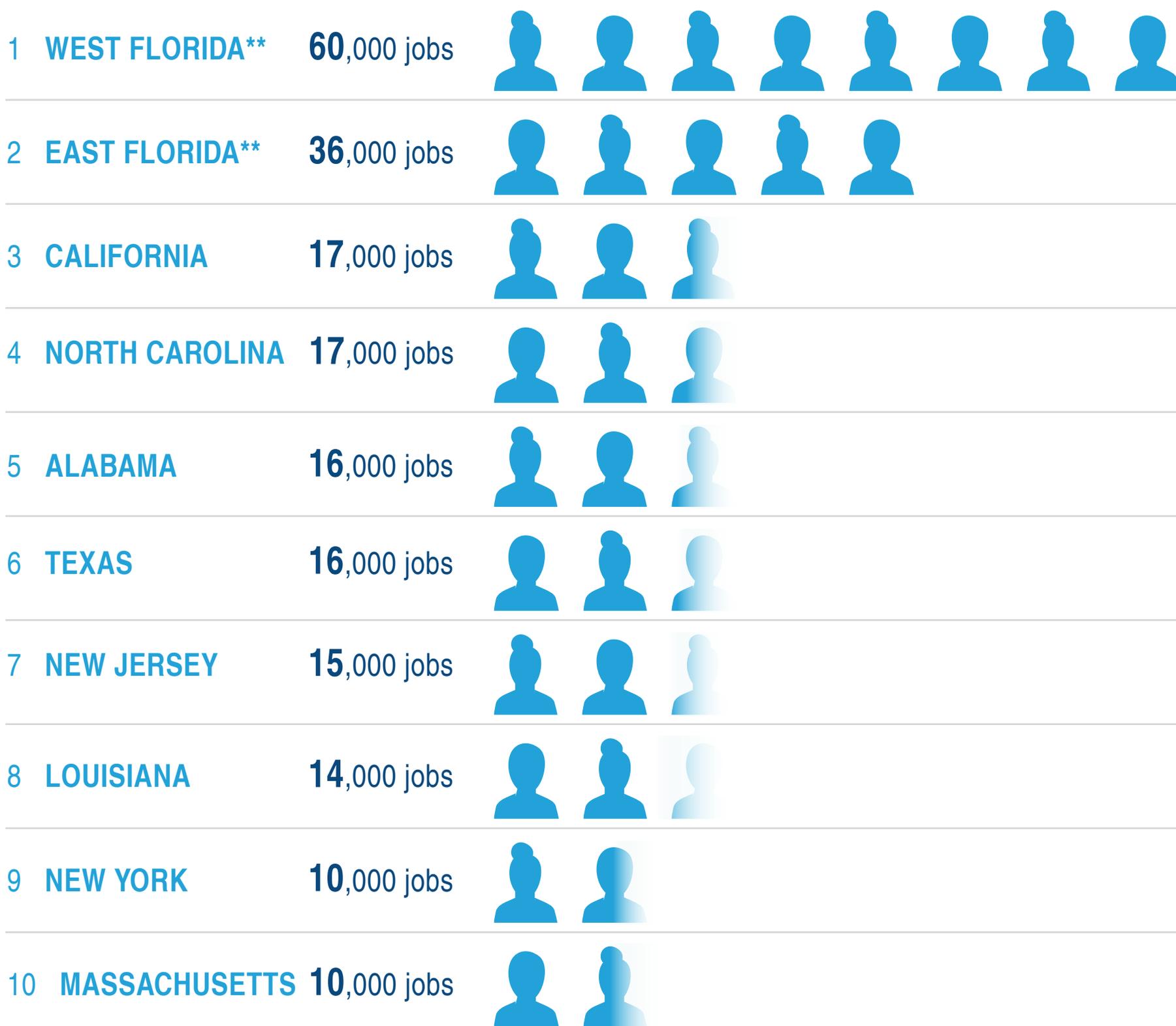

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Total Jobs Supported by U.S. Recreational Fishing Industries by State, 2016*



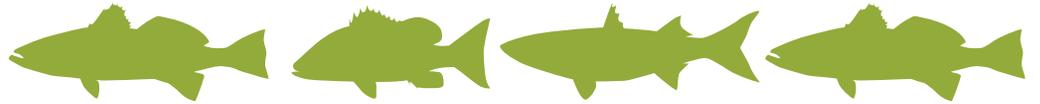
