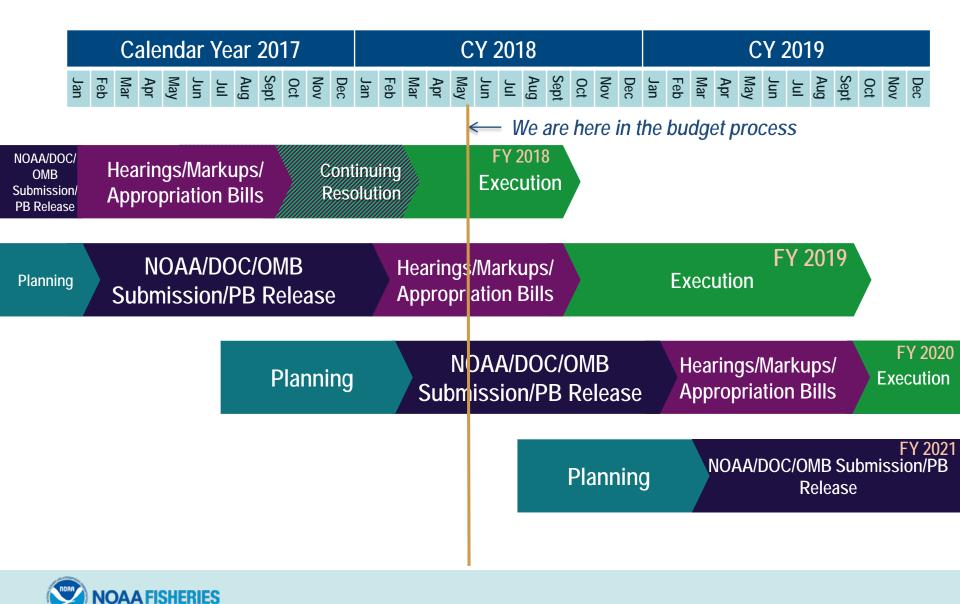

The Federal Budget Timeline



Many steps before funding is available

Budget Preparation and Review

Budget Planning

Budget planning, priorities guidance.

Budget Formulation -President's Budget Request

Guidance from NOAA, DOC, and OMB is provided to formulate the budget. Budget request to Congress is released the 1st Monday in February.

Congressional Action

Hearings & Mark-ups

Congress deliberates on the budget request typically through the spring and summer.

Appropriations

An appropriation bill is provided prior to the start of the fiscal year (Oct. 1).

Budget Execution Apportionment After the budget is appropriated, an apportionment must be signed to allow distribution of funds for obligation. **Rescissions & Other Costs** From the appropriated amounts, agencies are subject to rescissions and other

costs that must be accounted for before arriving at the funding available for a specific program or project.

Notable Language – FY 2018 Omnibus

Торіс	Language Summary
Councils and Commissions	 Does not override Senate Mark language to provide the additional funds (\$1.6M) to Commissions only.
Fishery Mgmt Council Fund Report	 Reporting requirement for all Councils on funding activity NOAA will work with the Committees and the Councils to establish the appropriate scope and format for this report.
At Sea Monitoring Program / Standardized Bycatch Reporting Methodology	 NMFS must provide spend plan on all costs to fully fund ASM.
Seafood Import Monitoring Program	 Lifts stay on shrimp and abalone within 30 days of enactment. Directs NMFS to comply and establish traceability program by Dec. 31, 2018.
Red Snapper	 Retains the \$5.0M in NMFS' budget for red snapper activities.



Fishery Management Council Fund Report

- Committee directs NOAA to provide, within 90 days of enactment of the Omnibus bill:
 - Complete account of the last 5 years of funding activity of any fund or grant program controlled or managed by each Council
 - Include the use of such funds to influence administrative processes in any State or Territory
- Reports shall be done annually and published online
- NOAA is working to establish appropriate scope and format.



FY 2018 Councils Funding

- Each Council is receiving a 3rd release of funds for FY18 Q3.
 - This will bring each of your FY18 funding levels to ~75% of the anticipated FY18 total [administrative budget line]
- All budget lines on the Council Table will be released after:
 - The apportionment is signed at OMB
 - Final allocation/allotment procedures are completed.

FY 2018 Senate Mark Language: "Fishery Councils and Commissions.—No less than \$35,871,000 is provided to support the Regional Fishery Management Councils, Interstate Marine Fisheries Commissions, and International Fisheries Commissions, provided **any increase above the fiscal year 2017 enacted amounts shall be distributed only among the Interstate Marine Fisheries Commissions and International Fisheries Commission.**"

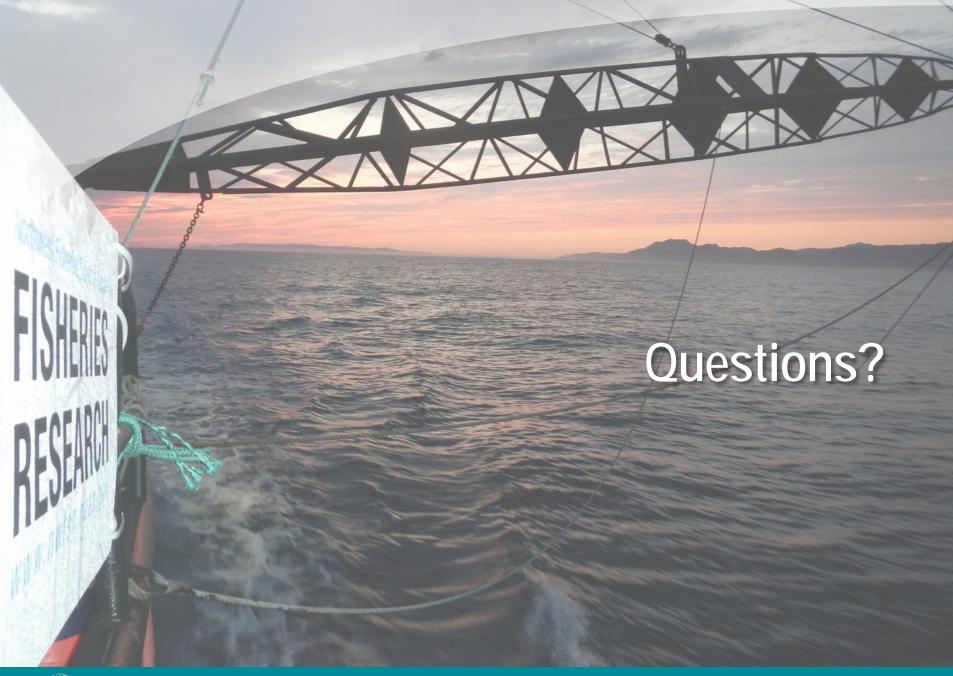

Additional FY 2018 Funding - Deregulation

- \$1.0 M being provided to Councils
- Distributed according to the Councils formula
- Specifically for deregulation activities under EO 13771/EO 13777 for the process previously discussed:
 - Council and RO staff are currently reviewing regulations
 - List of potential regulations will be presented to Council for review
 - There will be an opportunity for public comment
 - Council approval and submission of list to NMFS by July 1

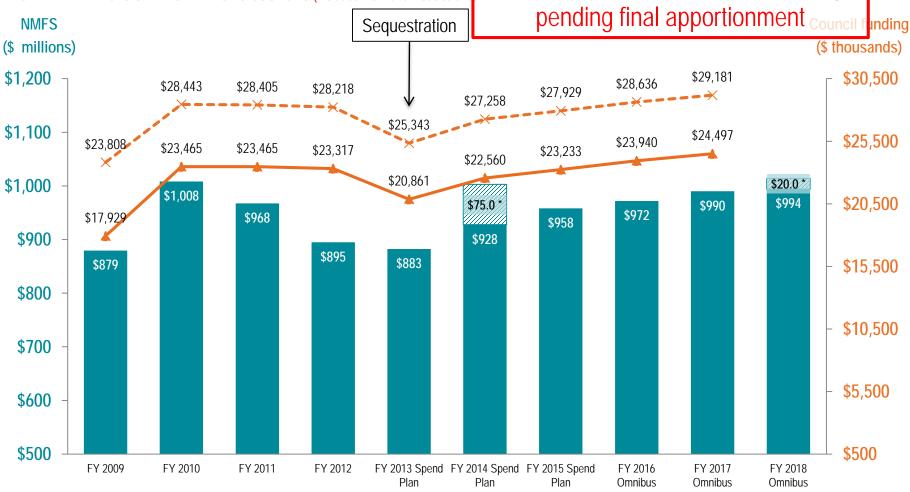
