It includes both existing measures that are currently used (or have been implemented in the past), potential measures recently discussed by the NEFMC's Recreational Advisory Panel, as well as new measures utilized in other fisheries or the commercial fleet.

Effort Controls	Limited entry, # days, # trips, (balance input and output controls – increase bag limits and decrease # trips)
Experimental Fishery	Temporary Exempted Fishing Permit to test certain measures, areas, or gear
Closed Areas	Spatial closures – permanent or temporary, with potential for near real-time, pending data availability
Boat Limits	Specific # fish for the boat overall or per person, can be single or mixed species
Size Limits	Slot limits, minimum size, maximum size
