


Gray triggerfish – Gulf of Mexico


Overfishing status is based on catch/overfishing limit (OFL). The estimated fishing mortality rate (F) compared to F_{MSY} is from the most recent stock assessment. A new rebuilding plan will be implemented in 2018.

- ⋯ Overfished $B/B_{MSY} \leq 0.625$


▲ Catch/OFL



Ocean pout - Northwestern Atlantic Coast




Sandbar shark - Atlantic and Gulf of Mexico




Thorny skate - Gulf of Maine

B_{msy} proxy is in kg/tow. Overfishing occurs if there is greater than a 20% decrease in the 3-year moving average. A negative ratio or a ratio < 1 represents a stock that is not subject to overfishing.




Windowpane - Gulf of Maine / Georges Bank



Winter flounder - Southern New England / Mid-Atlantic

This stock is under a second rebuilding plan, implemented in 2013, because the first rebuilding plan failed to make adequate progress.
